 - Typically we've spent the bulk of the budget for hiring employees
- Review current Teacher and Student Success Act Plan (TSSA)
 - The majority spent on hiring employee
 - Salary for a coach and half a teacher written out on TSSA plan as well
 - Stipend and Professional Development for teachers and staff

 - Challenge - how do you educate the community?
 - District made a video - Is this something to send out to parents? 7 min video
 - At least send SOMETHING out to parents. It's then up to the parents to familiarize themselves with the plan.
 - Start with an emailed plan to parents "What would you do in an Emergency?" to give them a sense of comfort and a timeline.
 - Bullet point plan - VERY simplified with links
 - Drill for reunification? Using employees/staff ONLY
